# Stock Review

## Stocks slide lower in 4Q

The fourth quarter was another punishing one for the stock market but it could have been worse if stocks hadn't bounced from the multiyear lows seen Nov. 20.

While no sectors in the Standard & Poor's 500 index were spared the heavy selling, investors gravitated toward utilities, health care and consumer staples. They are seen as safer bets in an unstable economy. Declines in these stocks in the final quarter of 2008 were about half those of other parts of the market.

Industrial and materials stocks were among the biggest decliners as investors grew nervous that a slowing economy would dampen demand. And financial stocks showed steep losses as Wall Street worried that spikes in bad debt would further imperil lenders.

The market's gyrations were at times stunning. In early October, the Dow Jones industrial average fell nearly 2,400 points, or 22.1 percent, in eight straight sessions. The next session, the Dow surged 936 points, an 11

percent gain that was its biggest rally since 1933.

The Dow industrials ended the year down 34 percent, their worst loss since 1931.

During 23 sessions from late October to late November, the S&P 500 surged 25 percent in six days, tumbled 25 percent the next 12 sessions and then jumped 20 percent in five days.

The Dow Jones Wilshire 5000 Composite Index, which reflects nearly all stocks traded in America, showed a paper loss of \$3.3 trillion for the quarter.

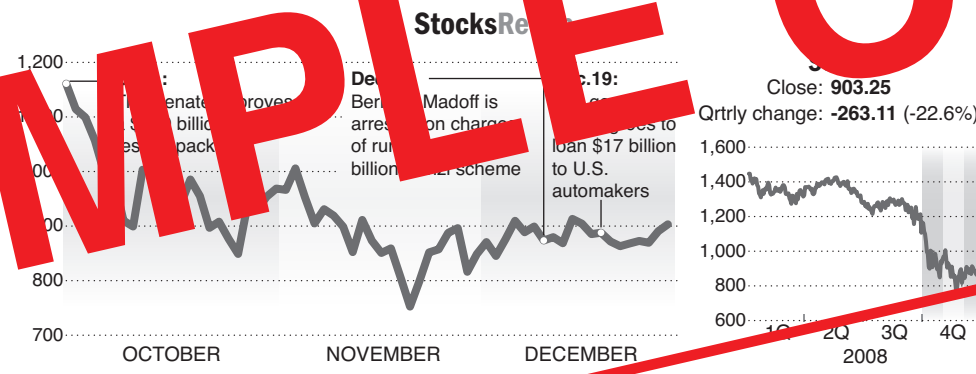
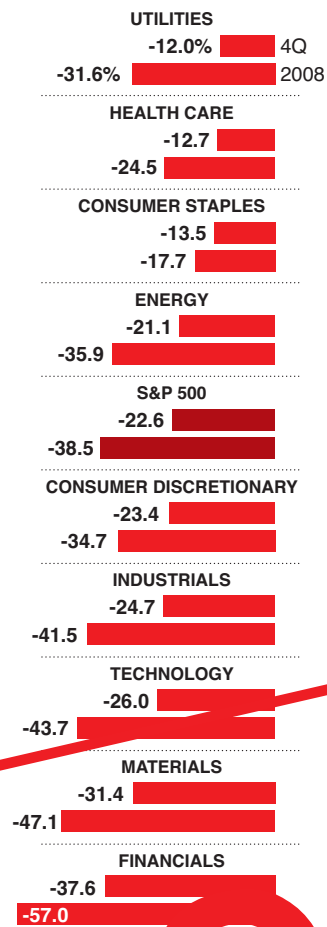
"The economy and the markets just fell off a cliff in a very short period of time," said Tim Speiss, head of the wealth management division at Eisner LLP.

With volatility easing in December some economists and market veterans are predicting the economy will rebound in the second half of 2009.

The government has announced a \$700-billion plan to support the financial sector and U.S. automakers. The Federal Reserve has slashed its benchmark interest rate to near zero to reduce borrowing costs.
